The above items should be kept in a **small clear pencil case only** to fit in a shallow tray.

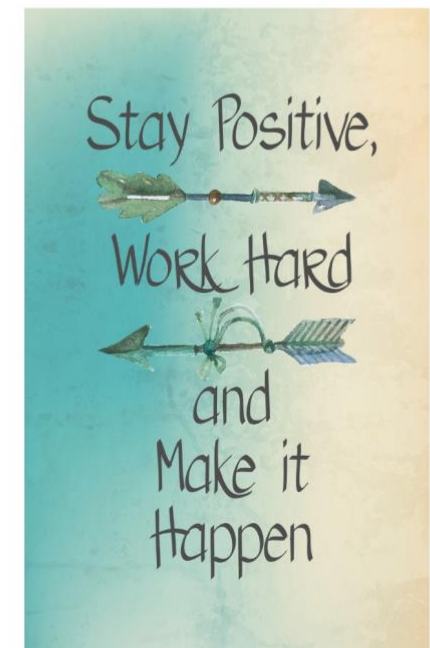
Reading

PE

English

In English, we will be focusing on the following genres of writing:

- ☐ Diary entry
- ☐ Narrative
- ☐ Biography
- ☐ Writing from another character's perspective.
- ☐ Poems including personification

Throughout the Autumn term we will be reading 'Letters from the lighthouse' and 'Rose Blanche' as our class books. We will also be developing and deepening the children's grammar knowledge.

Mathematics

Over this term we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, decimals, percentages and geometry. We will also be completing TT Rockstars regularly.

Science

Our topics this term are Electricity and Light. Children will be given the opportunity to ask and answer their own questions using a variety of electrical equipment.

Computing

We will be focusing on E-Safety and Bletchley Park encoding in the War.

Humanities

In history, we will be investigating the impact of WWII on the British people including the Battle of Britain, evacuation and the role of women. Geography focuses on where we get our energy from and includes a local field study.

Art & DT

In art we will explore how artists express ideas and use scale and perspective to do so. In DT we will be presenting a 'come dine with me' session where the children will cook parts of a three-course meal.
